

SATIN SMOOTH NOSE BEST

For years, hairdressers have been trimming their clients' nose hair with either shears or a trimmer. We're here to show you a few techniques that will bring you additional revenue and leave your clients clean, fresh and confident for several weeks with minimal pain and discomfort.

Nose Waxing Procedure:

- Have your guest fill out a client record card and consult with him or her before the procedure.
- Wash and sanitize your hands.
- Your guest must sit up straight in a chair.
- Select your wax; Satin Smooth Wild Cherry hard wax for medium to coarse hair or Calendula hard wax for coarse to stubborn hair.
- Ask guest the following questions:
Do you have asthma?
Are you prone to nose bleeds?
Are you taking any blood thinners?
Do you have a cold or a runny nose?



If he or she answers yes to any of these questions, the service cannot be performed.

- Dip a small applicator into the wax, so that a little ball of wax forms on the tip. Apply wax to the inside of the nose, squeeze nose and leave the applicator in.
- When wax hardens, grab the applicator with one hand, pinch the nose with the other hand and pull the applicator straight down.



- Repeat the same steps for the other nostril.
- Apply Satin Smooth Cool to a cotton swab, hand it over to your guest and have them gently apply the aloe to the inside of their nostrils. This cooling product will allow the pores to close while providing a small amount of antiseptic to the open pores.
- The guest should be hair-free for about three to four weeks.
